Curing

To help prevent the formation of plastic shrinkage cracks it is essential that the curing of concrete starts as soon as possible after the fresh concrete has been placed. Good curing is necessary to ensure that the desired properties of the concrete fully develop.

Health & Safety

Skin contact with fresh concrete can cause serious burns or dermatitis and protective clothing and eye protection should be worn when placing concrete. If skin contact occurs, wash immediately with soap and water. For eye contact, wash eyes thoroughly with clean water.



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
